THE ORTON-GILLINGHAM APPROACH TO TEACHING

This intense 10-day, 60-hour course provides the coursework requirements for AOGPE Associate Level certification: 45

hours of coursework in dyslexia, the brain, formal and informal testing, phonology,



history of language and morphology, handwriting, how language comprehension and word recognition impact reading, and the structure of language and how to teach it using the O-G Approach. It also includes 15 hours of applied practice, a mentor teacher will help attendees and a partner or two plan and implement seven 45-minute O-G lessons with a Riverside student and provide participants with daily observation and feedback.
