With Riverside School's membership, the online book database, **Bookshare**, is available to all students. Through **Bookshare** (www.bookshare.org), your child gets access to tens of thousands of accessible digital books over the Internet, as well as assistive reading tools that help them to read and study independently. Your child can also get access to **Bookshare** at home for FREE and the assistive reading tool software for PC, Mac, and NOOK HD/HD+, also FREE. (Other tablets require a software app of about \$20.)

Evenings, weekends, and summers--mysteries, fairy tales, science fiction, adventure stories---with **Bookshare**, students can read what they want, when they want on the Web or downloaded to a device!

Joining **Bookshare** offers a number of benefits:

- Access to the world's largest online library of accessible reading materials (books, textbooks, newspapers and magazines) for people with print disabilities.
- An unlimited library card, providing a steady flow and variety of new reading/listening materials anytime you want, seven days a week, 24 hours a day.
- Free access technology for reading books in the DAISY format.

Through an award from the US Department of Education Office of Special Education Programs, **Bookshare** offers free membership to US schools and qualifying US students. An individual membership allows any individual with a qualifying print disability to download books from **Bookshare**. Individuals can have their own individual membership and can also be listed on an organization's membership.

Parents wanting a **Bookshare** individual membership for their child's use at home should contact Ms. Myers for activation.
