Responsibilities:

- **Instruction**
 - Administer standardized and informal assessments three times per year
 - Plan and implement lessons using the OGA approach
 - Maintain record of students' work/activities and progress
 - Complete materials inventory at beginning and end of year
 - Receive OGA Observations each year coordinated by the OGA Fellow
- **Administrative**
 - Establish a supportive and trust-based relationship with students
 - Communicate with parents
 - Complete reports in Riverside Record Management System
 - Become familiar with students' case file for instruction
